



## **FEE RELIEF FOR CANDIDATES AFFECTED BY VICTORIAN BUSH FIRES 2009**

**The directors, examiners and administrative personnel of AMEB Victoria extend our sympathies to people who are experiencing personal and economic difficulties as a result of the February bushfires.**

Families and individuals who are experiencing financial hardship as a result of the bush fires may apply for relief from AMEB examination fees in 2009. An application form is available from the AMEB Victoria web-site ([www.ameb.unimelb.edu.au](http://www.ameb.unimelb.edu.au)) or may be obtained by telephoning the Victorian office (03 9882 3233). We are also very happy to re-issue AMEB certificates, to replace those that have been lost in the fires, on a complimentary basis.

### **TO APPLY FOR A COMPLIMENTARY EXAMINATION**

1. Complete a "standard" enrolment form.
2. Complete an **Application for Fee Relief 2009** form.
3. Complete a statutory declaration, stating that the candidate or his/her family are experiencing financial hardship as result of the February 2009 bushfires (no further details are required); it should be signed by the candidate (if over 18) or his/her parent/guardian and witnessed by a member of Victoria Police.
4. Deliver the enrolment, application, statutory declaration and payment for examination fees to the AMEB Victoria office by the closing date for entries for the particular examination session (by mail or in-person). It is not necessary to include the examination fee for the candidate who is applying for fee relief.
5. You will be advised if the application is subsequently approved (and, if an examination fee had been included with the enrolment, the fee will be refunded in full).
